Youth Events (3 Bird) \$ 45.00 per dog for members and \$ 80.00 per dog for non-members;
Non-Doubles Events (3 Bird) \$ 55.00 per dog for members and \$ 80.00 per dog for non-members;
Pointing Doubles Division (5 Birds) - \$ 50.00 per dog for members and \$ 75.00 per dog for non-members;
Flushing Doubles Division (5 Birds) - \$ 50.00 per dog for members and \$ 75.00 per dog for non-members.

1. You will note there are five (5) divisions in each category; see above. Please refer to the rules for each division you wish to run. Rules are posted on the website: www.RMtSDC.com
2. Youth (age 10-17) must have a hunter safety card. Youth (10-13) parent must be with them as they run.
3. **You may run multiple dogs in each division and/or in the different divisions.**

5. No checks will be deposited until after the trial. All non-member entrants must sign a liability waiver and mail it with your entry. Liability waiver can be downloaded off our web site, www.RMtSDC.com
6. Registrations will close the Wednesday before the trial. All entries will be handled on a first come, first served basis.
7. There will be two fields. Flushers, Youth, Women & Novice will run on one field; Open Pointing and Doubles will run on other field. Immediately after the trial, prizes will be awarded and photos taken for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place finishers in each division. ***Please stay for your photos so that we can post them on the website!***
8. The trial will start promptly at 8 AM, then after March start promptly at 7:30 AM. Each run at it's allotted time with a 5 minute period between runs. Thus there will be three runs per hour per field. There will be 15 minute breaks between divisions.
9. ***Youth and Ladies have first opportunity to clean fields after both fields are completed for the first 20 minutes!***

The top three finishers of each trial will qualify for the semifinals of the Club Championship to be held in May.

The top three finishers in both Open & Doubles Divisions earn points toward "Dog of the Year" in flushing and pointing categories.
